Visitors to Winona State are welcome to enjoy our campus wireless network using a temporary **WSU Guest wireless** account. Visitors can connect one device (e.g., phone, laptop, tablet) for 24 hours, after which they will need to renew their guest account. Connecting to WSU Guest wireless is not recommended for current WSU students or employees, who can connect to the Warrior and Wazoo networks using their StarID credentials.

Obtain guest access

To receive an access code and connect to our WSU Guest wireless network, follow these instructions:

- 1. While on campus, select **WSUGuest** from your list of available wireless networks. This will open a browser page.
- 2. Enter your name and your email address accept the Terms of Service, and select **Send Access Code**
- 3. Check your email for a message from no-reply@mist.com. If you don't see the message in your inbox, check your junk or trash folder. This message will contain your temporary access code. (you will need to check your email on your Cell phone or other device connected to a network)
- 4. Return to the browser window, enter your access code, and select **Sign In** (Fig 3). A window will appear indicating that you are connected to WSUGuest (Fig 5).




 Fig. 1 Enter your name and email
