Visitors to Winona State are welcome to enjoy our campus wireless network using a temporary **WSU Guest** wireless account. Visitors can connect one device (e.g., phone, laptop, tablet) for 24 hours, after which they will need to renew their guest account. Connecting to WSU Guest wireless is not recommended for current WSU students or employees, who can connect to the Warrior and Wazoo networks using their StarID credentials.

Obtain guess access

To receive an access code and connect to our WSU Guest wireless network, follow these instructions:

- 1. While on campus, select **WSUGuest** from your list of available wireless networks. This will open a browser page.




Fig 1. Choose how to receive your access code

- 2. Choose whether to receive your access code via email or text message (Fig 1).
- Enter your name and your email address or mobile number, accept the Terms of Service, and select Send Access Code (Fig 2). If you opt for a text message, you will need to choose your mobile carrier (Fig 3).
- 4. Check your mail or text messages for a message from **no-reply@mist.com**. If you opted for email and you don't see the message in your inbox, check your junk or trash folder. This message will contain your temporary access code.
- 5. Return to the browser window, enter your access code, and select **Sign In** (Fig 4). A window will appear indicating that you are connected to WSUGuest (Fig 5).
